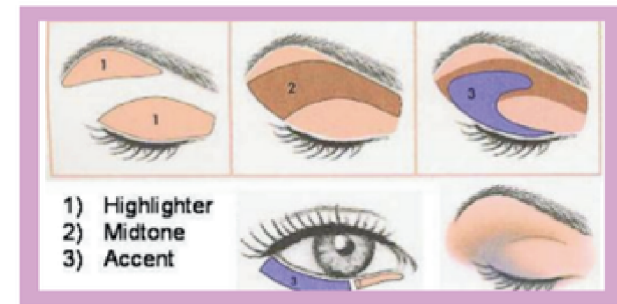


Average Eyes



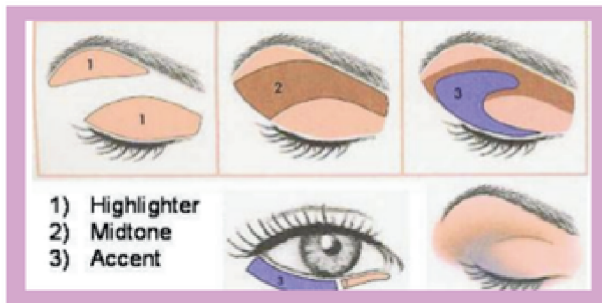
- With an average eye, you can see the lid, the crease, and the brow bone. It takes three eye shadow colors to shape the eye: a highlight, midtone, and contour shade.
- The basic rule to remember is that everything you highlight will come toward you or become more prominent. And everything you contour or darken will recede or move away from you.
- Using three shades creates a subtle visual trick to help bring out one of your most beautiful features—your eyes.

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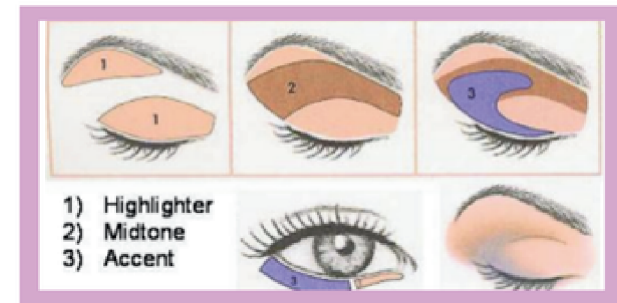
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
